
Albany Speed Hump Evaluation Criteria

(based on 30-mph City Speed Limit)



	Criteria	
	Roads with posted speeds	
	greater than 30 mph are	
	ineligible for vertical traffic	
	calming.	
	Major collectors and arterials	
	are ineligible for vertical traffic	
	calming.	
	Roadways with more than two	
	travel lanes or widths greater	
	than 50 feet are ineligible for	
	vertical traffic calming.	
	Traffic volumes should be	
	considered. Roadways with very	
	low traffic volumes (less than	
	500 vpd) or higher traffic	
	volumes (greater than 3,500	
	vpd) may not be appropriate for	
	vertical traffic calming.	
	Roadways with grades steeper	
	than 8 percent are not eligible	
	for vertical traffic calming.	
	Vertical traffic calming should be	
	considered in consultation with	
	CDTA and may need special	
	design considerations.	
	Vertical traffic calming should be	
	considered in consultation with	
	police, fire, and EMS, and may	
	need special design	
	considerations.

Speed hump request denied. Other traffic calming measures may be considered. Once a speed count is conducted on a given street, it will not be revisited for a minimum of five years unless known changes have taken place that may have significantly altered traffic conditions.
